



London Cycling Club Social Media Policy statement

1. Introduction

The London Cycling Club (LCC) has one social media outlet, which is a Facebook page found at <https://www.facebook.com/groups/18527901447/>. This Facebook page is a private group for current members of the LCC only. Posting on this page is a privilege of having a membership with the LCC.

2. Eligibility

To be eligible to post on this page, one must be a currently registered member of the LCC. For the purposes of the Facebook page, members are considered to be current:

- a) From the time they are initially registered as a member of the LCC until June 1st of the next calendar year; (if they have not signed up as members again) and
- b) Have not had their “privilege to post” removed as defined per Section 10 below.

3. Accepting new members

LCC memberships are only available from early March until the last LCC ride in late October. The LCC’s Facebook page will only accept new members during that period, once they have formally signed up with the LCC.

4. Removal due to inactive status

Persons currently belonging to the LCC’s Facebook page will be removed if they have not signed up as a member of the LCC by June 1st of the current calendar year.

5. Purpose

The Facebook Page is provided for the convenience of LCC members and posts should be confined to matters relating to cycling or the LCC.

6. Prohibited Activities

The following are prohibited:

a. Unsanctioned events

No notices, invitations, or ad hoc rides posted on the Facebook page shall constitute sanctioned events of the LCC. Only events and rides posted on the London Cycling Club website at <http://www.londoncyclingclub.ca/> are considered sanctioned events by the LCC.

b. Advertising

This site is not to be used for advertising, sales, or promotion of products, services or events unless approved by the LCC Board of Directors.

7. Comments

Anything posted on this Facebook page is subject to the LCC’s Bullying and Harassment Policy.



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8. Governance

The Facebook page is governed by administrators representing the LCC Board of Directors.

9. Removal of content

The administrators, as per Section 8 of this policy, reserve the right to delete any post or comment they consider to be in violation of the spirit of Sections 5, 6 or 7 of this policy.

10. Removal of members' privilege to post

Repeated infractions of Sections 5, 6 & 7 may result in the members' losing the privilege to post.

11. Duration of Removal

The duration of the removal as per Section 10 will be for the remainder of the cycling club season and until the next year the member signs up with the LCC.

12. Appeal

There is no formal appeal process. Members who have had their privilege to post removed may write to the club explaining why they wish to be reinstated prior to the length of duration outlined in Section 11. The Board of Directors will review any written submissions in due course.
